Marcia, 32: I collect tickets. I've got a huge collection of more than 900 tickets. I keep all kinds of tickets, bus, train and plane tickets, cinema tickets, theatre tickets, concert tickets, etc. I stick them in books and write the date next to the ticket. The oldest ticket in my collection is a bus ticket which I bought at the age of eight. That's when I had the idea to start a collection. My collection helps me remember



the places and events I've been to. Sometimes I take out my books and look through them. Some of my friends think that I'm a bit crazy, but I love my hobby and I will continue collecting a lot more tickets in the future.
